Established on Feb. 20, 1942, the force spearheaded such World War II amphibious campaigns as Guadalcanal, Leyte, Iwo Jima and Okinawa.

Today, approximately 20,000 men assigned to some 70 ships and supporting units make up the force, commanded by Vice Adm. Howard A. Yeager. The Pacific amphibs are capable of transporting and landing combat-ready Marines and their equipment across the beaches of any trouble spot in the Pacific, the Far East or Southeast Asia.

Glenn G. Gooder, dean of student personnel at Harbor College, has been selected to serve on a special tax and bond information center established at the Board of Education offices.

As a junior college representative at the information center he will appear before community and civic groups to promote the passage of the proposed school bonds and tax increase in the June 5 election. It is anticipated that the junior colleges will be asking for approval of \$24,000,000 in the bond issue. Harbor College is scheduled to receive over \$3,000,000 of this for the completion of its building program.
