

South 9 Visits Redondo In Bid to Continue Streak

Upholding its tradition of being a great late-season baseball club, South High bombarded Redondo, 6 to 1, on Tuesday, rattling the Seahawks' chances for a second place finish in the Bay League.

South faced loop-leader Morningside and powerful North in the first two series of the campaign without the services of ace moundsman Ken Turner, out with pulled stomach muscles.

TURNER HAS worked himself back into condition rapidly and with him have come the Spartans. The hard-throwing lefty hurled a brilliant one-hitter against Redondo on Tuesday, going the entire route to post the win. Using his fast ball to pull him out of tight spots, Turner demonstrated a sharp-breaking curve as he chalked up 12 strikeouts while walking only three Seahawks.

RAY SHAEFFER was saddled with the defeat despite a fine hurling performance. Shaeffer allowed eight hits, whiffed nine batters and gave out only three free passes, but five errors sent him reeling into defeat. Redondo opened the first frame with a hit and a run for its only tally of the contest. From there on it was all South.

The South third, Randy McKay quickly sent him across with a two-bagger, and Turner came in to help out his own cause, singling to drive in McKay.

It was a tight ball game until the sixth when South erupted for four runs to ice the contest.
