

Normandie - 220th Crossing To Get Signals, Lights

The County and City of Los Angeles have agreed to share the costs of installing a traffic control signal system with high safety lighting at the intersection of Normandie Avenue and 220th Street, it was disclosed by County Supervisor Burton W. Chace.

As part of the agreement, the existing signal system and safety lighting at the intersection of Normandie Avenue and Carson Street will be modified. The total project will cost \$7,800, of which the county will pay \$1,950, or 25 per cent. The city will pay the other 75 per cent, or \$5,850 of the project cost.

The proportion to be paid by each agency is based on the

number of intersection roadways under their respective jurisdictions.

THE CITY will prepare the plans and specifications for the improvement and will supervise the project and will also maintain and operate the signals. The county will reimburse the city for its share of the installation, maintenance, and operational costs.

"Normandie Avenue, Carson Street, and 220th Street are County Master Plan highways and Carson Street is a Major highway," Chace said.

Corona del Camino is an honorary student leadership alumni society. Members are chosen for service in various activities, including student government, athletics, drama, music, forensics, and journalism.


New board members are Wayne Hren, Wayne Overbeck, Marie Gantner, and Karen Sake.






