

# Nativity Nabs Track Title

Nativity Elementary, defending co-champ, established a new record Saturday in winning the annual Torrance Optimist Club track meet at Torrance High.

Competing against 29 elementary schools, Nativity ran up 29 1/2 points to erase the old record of 25 points set by Perry Elementary in 1960.

Trailing the winners were Greenwood, 12 1/2; Seaside, 11 1/2; Victor, 9; Flavian, 8 1/2; Madrona, 8; Crenshaw, 6; Edison, 5 1/2; Walteria and Hamilton, 5; and Torrance and Madison, 4 1/2 points.

ONE NEW RECORD was set and six were tied as 377 athletes entered the eight events.

Nativity's Mike Fornelli came out on top in the shot put, setting a new record of 48-4 to remove from the record books the 1958 mark of El Nido's Wayne Wright.

FOLLOWING Fornelli in the shot were Doug Kelsey, Greenwood, 44-4; Steve Parker, Seaside, 40-9; Tony Zarazua, Cren-

shaw, 39-9; and Scott Steele, Victor, 38-6.

Tying the century mark of 11.3 seconds set in 1960 by Chuck Carpenter from Crenshaw, Don Tippie captured the 100-yard dash for Nativity.

DON CARIFI, Edison; Steve Linsky, Victor; Bob Lucic, Flavian, and Tokio Katsuki, Edison, pushed Tippie to the record-tying performance.

John Ziempe, competing for Nativity, was the only spiker to earn two victories. Ziempe captured both the 70-yard hurdles and the broad jump.

DOUG KELSEY ran the 180-yard dash in 20.3 seconds to win for Greenwood. Craig Steinberg, Greenwood; Mike O'Brien, Nativity; Glenn McGraw, Madison and Steve Quadorzzi, Steele, also placed in the event.

In the 440-yard run, Seaside's Jim Reed led a tightly packed field across the wire in 63 seconds. Bill Foley, Carr; Earl Gardner, Madrona; Scott Reading, Madison; Bill Flanery, Edison; Steve Parker, Seaside; and Rick Button, Edison, trailed Reed across the finish.

SCOTT STEELE won the football throw for Victor at 150 feet with Mike Chapman, Crenshaw, 145-6; Jim Discanso, Seaside, 144-3; Glen Reasbeck, Nativity, 141-3 and Jim Crockett, Torrance, 138-5 pushing for top honors.

Steve Sibley sailed 4-9 in the high jump to take the win for Hamilton. Dennis Burns, Flavian; Terry Tiedem, Torrance; Joel Hons, Steele; and John Randall, Madrona, each jumped 4-6 with places being determined by number of misses.
