

# Workers Begin Construction of Large Shopping Center at Carson, Normandie

Construction has begun on the \$2,000,000 Carson Shopping Center at Carson Street and Normandie Avenue, which will service residents of Torrance and surrounding communities.

Developers of the seven-acre project are Arthur N. and Norman A. Reicher. Completion of the major portion of the project by Ernest W. Hahn, Inc., general contractor, is scheduled for Sept. 15.

Center is contemporary with broad use of glass and stone in all buildings. Liberal landscaping will accent the concrete and brick facades.

PARKING AT THE center, which is located one block west of the new Harbor General Hospital, will accommodate 440 cars. The center is rectangular and faces Carson Street, with the exception of the bank, which is on Normandie Avenue.

General contractor for the Boys' Market is Stanley Construction Co. Other architects involved on the project include Robert H. Peterson, AIA, who designed the market, and George T. Nowak, architect and associates, designer of the Pacific State Bank branch.
