Improvement Slated for Carson Park

Plans and specifications for a \$123,000 County recreational area at Carson Neighborhood Park have been completed and the project will be advertised for bids in the near future.

The proposed development provides for a recreation activity building of 1800 square feet. A walled patio area with outdoor stage and planter area will adjoin the main building. Parking for 31 cars, softball diamonds, playground equipment, basketball and volleyball courts, and a picnic area are to be included.

Landscaping, provisions for a sprinkler system and drinking fountains, lighting, and drainage facilities are provided for in the plans.

Construction time for the entire project is estimated at 150 days.

Construction Work Closes Figueroa St.

Figueroa Street will be closed to all but local traffic in the Carson area for about nine months, it was announced here yesterday.

During the period construction work is slated for a bridge over the Dominguez Channel. The work will be completed in May, 1963.

Plans and specifications for the bridge, located at Moneta Avenue, were completed by the County Road Department and approved by the Board of Supervisors last week.

Traffic will be detoured around the project site during the construction. The Anelo Avenue bridge will remain open until new access is provided for motorists.

The project will be opened for bids Aug. 14.




