

State Claims 47 Bands in Youth Music Movement

Meredith Willson's colorful story of "The Music Man" has a modern day sequel right here in Southern California, where the largest youth band movement in the United States is under way.

Under the guidance of the Youth Band Council of Southern California and the Los Angeles County Music Commission, local youth bands, made up of talented young musicians from 10 to 21, now number over 47 separate organizations. Each band is an extra-curricular recreation activity for the youngsters who compose the bands.

BANDS in the local area are sponsored by civic, lodge, and community organizations. More than 10,000 pre-teen and teen-age youths are actively participating in the youth bands which represent nearly every city and community in

Los Angeles and surrounding counties.

These 47 bands provide musical entertainment at nearly all special events and parades in Southern California, and many have traveled throughout the United States, Canada and Europe.

A NUMBER of the youth bands will represent their communities at the Seattle World's Fair this year, presenting concerts at the Concourse of Flags.

Every year, under the sponsorship of the Youth Band Council, the youth bands mass in some community and perform together in several spectacular musical events second only to the parade of "76 Trombones" in Willson's script.

Among these events are the Annual Youth Band Festival in Hollywood Bowl, Youth

Band Day at Disneyland, and the Youth Band Adjudication and Musician's Clinic at South Gate.

ON SEPTEMBER 22, 34 of the bands will provide a patriotic massed band "Salute to Sousa" during half-time festivities at the nationally televised USC vs. Duke football game in the Coliseum.

Activities of the youth bands are sponsored by the member organizations, the Los Angeles County Music Commission, and patrons of the youth bands. Patron subscriptions are \$25 per year.
