boundary is south on the city boundary to 174th Street.

The southern boundary is west on 174th Street to Casimir Avenue, south on Casimir Avenue to the prolongation of the rear property line of the homes on the south side of 178th Street, west along this prolongation to Crenshaw Boulevard. The western boundary is north along Crenshaw Boulevard to the Dominguez Channel.

FERN - GREENWOOD ELEMENTARY — The northern boundary is from a prolongation of the property lines between Kornblum Avenue and Teri Avenue east along the easterly spur of the Santa Fe and Los Angeles Harbor railroad to Crenshaw Boulevard, south along Crenshaw Boulevard to a prolongation of the back property line of the homes on the south side of 2242 203rd Street, north along a prolongation of this property line to the easterly spur of the Santa Fe and Los Angeles Harbor railroad, east along the railroad to the western property line of 2210 203rd Street.

The eastern boundary is created by a line along the western property line of 2210 203rd Street, south to Dominguez Street, west to the alley between Amapola Avenue and Madrid Avenue, south to the alley between Sierra Street and Torrance Boulevard, west on this alley to Madrid Avenue, south to Carson Street, west to Crenshaw Boulevard, south to Sepulveda Boulevard.

THE SOUTHERN boundary is west on Sepulveda Boulevard to the intersection of a southerly prolongation of the property lines between Juniper Avenue and Flower Avenue. The western boundary is north along the prolongation of the property lines between Juniper Avenue and Flower Avenue and along these property lines and the western property lines of 2846 Onrado Street and El Dorado Street, continuing north along the property lines between Kornblum Avenue and Fonthill Avenue to Torrance Boulevard, east on Torrance Boulevard to the property lines between Kornblum Avenue and Teri Avenue, and north along these property lines and their prolongation to the Santa Fe and Los Angeles Harbor railroad.

CRENSHAW ELEMENTARY — The northern boundary is from the Edison Co. right-of-way east on 182nd Street to the San Diego Freeway, southeast on the San Diego Freeway right-of-way to the city boundary. The eastern boundary is south on Western Avenue to 190th Street.

The southern boundary is west on 190th Street to Yukon Avenue. The western boundary is north on Yukon Avenue to a point between 187th Street and 185th Street which a prolongation of 186th Street would intersect, east from this point to the Edison Co. right-of-way, and north on the right-of-way to 182nd Street.

Children living on 203rd Street at street number 2342 and larger shall also be in the Crenshaw School attendance zone.

Jefferson Elementary School boundaries will remain unchanged as will all other boundaries.

Bank Gets Processing Equipment

Data processing equipment has been installed in the newly remodeled and expanded home office of the Pacific State Bank. The automatic equipment will be on display when the bank holds its grand opening Aug. 18.

Visitors to the newly expanded banking offices will be taken on a guided tour of the bank's new IBM electronic inscribers. The center will serve as a high speed check processing point for all six branches of the bank.

Stars, aerospace models, and major league ball players are also slated to be on hand for the grand opening. Hours for the event are from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Free gifts and free rides for the children are also featured.

Also slated to open soon is the bank's Torrance branch, located in the Carson area.

3rd Graders Get Longer Class Time

Ten Torrance elementary schools will extend the day for third grades beginning in September following action by the Board of Education Monday night.

To determine the effect of this added time on the added academic achievement of children, the administration will select 10 other schools which are maintaining the existing schedule, and compare the gain in achievement of the two groups.

THIS WILL involve testing about 825 children in extended day classes, and a comparison group of 815 children in regular day classes.

The 825 children in the experimental group represent about 31 per cent of the total third grade enrollment.

The Trustees expended \$1,640 for the study between the two groups.

In other action, the Board received figures on summer school attendance for the current term.

ENROLLMENT on June 29 was 7,682 for the elementary grades and 3,342 for the high schools. The total of 11,024 was considerably higher than the 10,241 total for the previous year.

At the end of the sixth week, there were 5,937 students still enrolled in the elementary grades and 3,091 in the high schools. The total came to 9,028 as compared to 7,749 last year.
