

Five English Instructors to Join El Camino in September

Five English instructors will be added to the humanities division of El Camino College when classes open on Sept. 11. Instructing students enrolled in the division headed by Harry L. Ruby of Inglewood will be Robert H. Brown, Regis C. Ginn, Richard O. Hauge, Frederic L. Milstein, and Leo E. Sullivan.

The third man of his surname in the humanities division, Hugh Brown joins Donald W. and Clarence E. in the

department and Gerald W. and Lloyd L. on the faculty.

A native of Missouri, he holds a bachelor's degree from Park College of that state and a master's degree in English from the University of Iowa. He has taught previously at Western Michigan University, Tri-State College in Indiana and at Michigan Tech. He will move to Southern California from his home in Kansas City, Mo.

SULLIVAN, currently residing in Downey, comes to El Camino from Sierra High School in Whittier, where he has taught for the past two years. Previous to coming to California, he taught in three south Dakota high schools. He was principal of Howard High School in Howard, S. D.

A veteran of the U.S. Army, Sullivan received his bachelor's degree in education from General Beadle Teachers College in Madison, S.D. After securing his master of arts de-

gree from Colorado State Teachers College, he continued in post-graduate work at South Dakota State College in Brookings.

A professional actor and vocalist, Milstein has appeared in productions in England, Germany, and Switzerland. He received his BA degree from the University of California at Los Angeles and received letters of proficiency in the German language and in operatic and dramatic arts from the University

of Munich and the Vienna State Academy of Music and Dramatic Art.

THE NEW instructor has taught at University High School and Emerson Junior High in Los Angeles, at the Rhein-Main Air Base Depend-ent School in Frankfurt, Germany, and the Vienna International Community School in Austria.

Also coming to Southern California from South Dakota

will be Hauge, whose home is in Brookings. He is a graduate of Huron College and South Dakota State College, where he received both the BS and master in education degrees.

The Navy veteran has taught in the public schools of Arlington, S. D., and Pipestone, Minn., in addition to South Dakota State in Brookings.

Coming from Wasco, where he was most recently serving as a teacher in Wasco Union High School, Ginn has also taught at the University of Arizona and in Roskrige Junior High School in Tucson.
