Harbor Hospital Gets Clinical Fellowships

Two of the five Clinical Fellowships awarded by the American Cancer Society in the state of California will be in effect during the next year at Harbor General Hospital.

Clinical Fellowships—post-graduate training of promising young physicians and dentists—are proving to be a valuable method employed by the American Cancer Society to insure that special knowledge of cancer problems is passed along to other doctors through local hospitals and medical and dental societies.

One of the Harbor General Fellowships will be in surgery under the direction of Dr. Marshall J. Orloff; the second, in pathology, under the direction of Dr. Dean L. Moyer. Both are grants effective from July 1, 1963, through June 30, 1964.

Marineland Again Hosts Red Nichols

Red Nichols is back again for the fifth time at Marineland Restaurant in Palos Verdes, tooting his golden cornet and leading his famous Five Pennies in the "Porpoise Room," where this week's opening was a five-starred blockbuster!

Playing jazz treatments of the old Dixieland favorites, Nichols was welcomed by the loyal legions who applauded and cheered the horn that's been heard 'round the world. Many more jazz buffs, particularly fans of the musical idols of the 20s, already have started to make reservations in the "Porpoise Room."

THE FIVE PENNIES, however, continue to win a whole new generation of patrons of

the Nichols' art with infectious sounds that swing from brassy cornet solos and down-beat jazz to a stream of Dixieland classics.

One of the most enduring musical institutions in American jazz, Nichols performs at Marineland Restaurant in a fluid, highly inventive style. Behind his superbly controlled cornet are blending companion instruments.

HIS SIDEMEN, no strangers to the rhythmic forms of New Orleans and Chicago, splash their repertoire with imaginative combinations of instrumental color.

Red Nichols and his band, featuring Joe Rushton on sax, entertain nightly except Mon-

days in the "Porpoise Room," where reservations are advisable.

The hot-noted Five Pennies, who came to Marineland from a triumphant Denver engagement, will next play at The Flamingo in Las Vegas.
