## Engle Moves to Protect California Farm Markets

Sen. Clair Engle (D-Calif.) has urged the Senate Finance Committee to amend the Trade Expansion Act to protect California's specialty crop growers against adverse import rules.

California specialty crops include walnuts, cherries, wine, olives, figs, lemon concentrates and filberts.

Senator Engle's amendment specifies that U.S. agricultural products with 95 per cent home consumption would be exempt from the Trade Act unless a reciprocal trade agreement is negotiated with foreign producers.

The amendment would give protection to California specialty crops which are not, in general, concerned with the export market and which are vulnerable to imports from other countries.

## SDA School To Be Open Next Tuesday

Those "good old golden rule days" of school will begin a week early for Torrance students attending Long Beach Seventh-day Adventist Elementary school, 4951 Oregon Ave., R. C. Lyman, principal of the school said yesterday.

Lyman said classes at the parochial school will open next Tuesday, about a week before the majority of Torrance youngsters trek back to the city's public schools.

Anticipating an enrollment increase of about 10 per cent in this year's attendance, Lyman said, "It is traditional for Adventist schools to open the day after Labor Day. Special scheduling through the year makes this advantageous to our program."

Registration of students is being held today.

The local Seventh-day Adventist parochial school is one of 36 operated by the denomination in Los Angeles, Santa Barbara, and Ventura counties.

Some 4,600 students will be in attendance during the 1962-63 school year.
