Garden Valley Assn., founded in June 1960, once again starts its fall semester.

The school is open to children that are mentally retarded, physically handicapped, mongoloid, emotionally disturbed, and/or epileptic.

Currently operating are four classes daily—Monday through Friday. The Training Center is the only organized program, in the Southwest-Bay area, accepting these children 4 years of age and over, regardless of degree of retardation.

Tuition is \$35 a month with the funds going to two trained teachers in this field. Appointment for interview

The Training Center is located at 1119 W. Redondo Beach Blvd. in Gardena, but the program is open to all communities.

Large Crowd Salutes New Bruinsma Office

Largest crowd ever to attend the opening of a political campaign headquarters in the 17th Congressional District was on hand this past weekend for the official debut of the "Bruinsma for Congress" office in Torrance.

"You are here in such great numbers because there is such great need for a new congressman in this district," nominee Ted Bruinsma told the audience. "You have diagnosed the problems of this area as being caused by anemic representation due to under-active congressman, and you are right."

"We are going to conduct the most vigorous campaign this district has ever seen, because we want to show every voter how hard a congressman should work for their interests. In these crucial times Congress is not the place for anyone to conduct the type of on-the-job retirement evidenced by our present representative."

MORE THAN 30 per cent of those attending the Bruinsma headquarters opening were registered Democrats, according to Bruinsma campaign director John Christman.

"Just for curiosity we asked for a show of hands. With this kind of two-party in-

terest, I predict Ted Bruinsma will be providing the 17 District with the working representation it needs when the new Congress convenes next January," Christman said.

Bruinsma's Torrance headquarters, located at 2170 Torrance Blvd., will serve as his main campaign office. Other Bruinsma headquarters are also functioning in San Pedro and Gardena.

Opening of the Torrance headquarters drew crowds from Compton, San Pedro, Redondo Beach, Hawthorne, Lawndale and Gardena.

Arrangements for the event were under the direction of Bob Scott and Ron Owens.






