



Armeo Scholarship Program Announced

A four-year scholarship, valued at \$650 a year, will again be awarded to some high school senior in the Los Nietos-Torrance area by Armeo Steel Corp. The scholarship here is one of 20 offered by Armeo in the communities where it has plants. It was established in 1959, following the merger of The National Supply Co. with Armeo. Fluid Packed Pump, Los Nietos, is part of National Supply. Robert K. Weatherwax Jr., of 610 Strub Ave., Whittier, was the winner of the 1962 scholarship. Competition for the 1963 scholarship is open to seniors in public, private, or parochial schools in the Torrance or Whittier school districts who plan to major in engineering, chemistry, or physics. It is not limited to sons and daughters of National Supply employees. However, sons and daughters of employees at National's Torrance or Los Nietos plants are eligible to compete even if they attend high schools in adjacent communities.

THE WINNER may attend any accredited college or university. If the winner enrolls in a privately-supported institution, that institution will receive \$500 a year additional from the Armeo Foundation as a cost-of-education supplement.

An additional scholarship, known as the George M. Verity Memorial Scholarship, is open only to sons and daughters of Armeo or National Supply employees, without geographical limitation. This also is a four-year scholarship, but is valued at \$1,000 for the first year, and \$750 for each of the three following years.

APTITUDE tests will be given in the high schools Oct. 16 and 20.

Full particulars about the competition, covering who is eligible, how to apply, and how winners are selected, are contained in a booklet entitled "Armeo Community Scholarships."


