

Local Realtors to Attend 58th Annual Association Convention

Jack Schmidt, president of the Torrance-Lomita Board of Realtors, announced that plans are now complete for the 58th annual convention of the 38,000 member California Real Estate Assn., to be held in San Francisco, Oct. 7-11, according to information received from Charles H. Brown of Pasadena, president of the state association. The San Francisco Real Estate Board is host for the five-day meeting.

Governor Edmund G. Brown and former Vice President Richard M. Nixon are both scheduled to address general sessions of the convention, Brown on Tuesday, Oct. 9, and Nixon on Thursday, Oct. 11, Schmidt reported. Ronald Reagan, popular motion picture and television star, will be the keynote speaker at the conclave which will be attended by more than 4,000 members of the 171 real estate boards in the state said Schmidt.

A LARGE delegation from the Torrance-Lomita Board area is planning to attend the convention, according to Mr. Schmidt. Eighteen members are planning to attend. The Board of Realtors is sending four realtor directors including Rose Craig, Del Vaughn, Le Dawson, and Board President Jack Schmidt. Two salesman directors, Norine Burgess and Don Mario will attend. Mario will also give the "Torrance, My Hometown" speech in a competition among boards. In addition to the directors there will be the board public relations chairman Geneva Meara and the executive secretary Forest Beyrer.


