

## Free Enterprise at Stake Tuesday, Christopher Says

San Francisco Mayor George Christopher, candidate for Lt. Governor, declared Tuesday that Soviet Premier Khrushchev, with whom Christopher once talked in Moscow, hopes "the United States will spend ourselves into a condition of weakness that will lead inevitably to our collapse."

Christopher then cited the record of big spending in California where the budget increased from \$2 billion to \$3 billion in the past four years.

"In that same period we have seen our bonded debt doubled and the cost of servicing that debt go up 150 per cent," he added.

"WITH SO much of our wealth channeled into government, free enterprise faces an increasingly heavy challenge to maintain our strength," he said. "But too often we find government staffed by critics of free enterprise, men and women who have never

worked in private industry, never had to meet a payroll or expand a plant. They persist in chopping down the tree of free enterprise, using taxes and controls as the axe, in order to finance more of the spending which impairs our security.

"Facing the crisis as we do today, I believe next week's election is a critically important opportunity to staff our state government and national Congress with men and women of courage who respect free enterprise as a source of America's very great strength."

## Marymount Instructor Gets Americanism Medal

Dr. Anthony Butkovich, a member of the history department at Marymount College in Palos Verdes Estates, has been awarded the Americanism Medal of the Daughters of the American Revolution.

The presentation was made by Mrs. Frank R. Mettlach, state commander of the DAR, who cited Dr. Butkovich for his patriotic activities in connection with the establishment of the Freedom Documents Foundation.

Mrs. Mettlach pointed out that less than 100 American Medals have been awarded since the formation of the DAR organization.

Dr. Butkovich has also been on a concentrated lecture tour both here and abroad, speaking on the subject of Americanism, and adds that the Documents Foundation plans to prepare a total of 49 million copies of the historic reproductions.

The foundation is dedicated to the graphic reproduction of American historical documents for distribution throughout the nation in order to re-educate the people of the United States to the country's original heritage and greatness.

## TV Tour of Ancient Cities Set Saturday

A television tour of the remains of ancient cities will be coupled with scenes of modern metropolises to present a unique survey of the history of men and cities on "It Is Written," Saturday at 7:30 p.m. on KCOP-TV, Channel 13, Pastor Manson Metcalf of the Torrance Seventh-day Adventist Church, announced today.

"This telecast, called 'God and The Cities,' will scan the mound which today covers the site of ancient Nineveh, one-time capital of the Assyrian Empire," said Pastor Metcalf.

"The television cameras will also survey the stony ruins of the city of Babylon, magnificent center of the vast Babylonian empire."

Pastor Metcalf said scenes of old Petra, ancient center of sun-worship with its colorful red sandstone barriers against invaders, and modern Jerusalem, divided by barbed fire between Israelis and Arabs, will contrast on the screen cities of the past and present in the Near East.

The telecast is one of a series of weekly programs being sponsored by the Torrance Seventh-day Adventist Church, Pastor Metcalf said.
