





**Torrance Social Security Office to Open on Friday**

The new Social Security District Office at 1408 Crenshaw in Torrance will hold "open house" on Friday from 2 to 4 p.m. The occasion will begin with a ceremonial ribbon cutting at 2 o'clock.

According to Miles A. Davis, district manager, the opening of the new service office in Torrance resulted from the increasing volume of Social Security business incident to the rapid expansion of industry and population in the area. In addition to the city of Torrance, the office also serves Gardena, Harbor City, Hermosa Beach, Lawndale, Lomita, Manhattan Beach, Palos Verdes Estates, Redondo Beach, Rolling Hills, and Rolling Hills Estates.

**More Streets In Shoestring To Get Paving**

FORMERLY, residents of these areas had to go to the district office in Long Beach or Inglewood for service. The new location in Torrance, in addition to being out of the congested traffic area, is reasonably central to the several communities served.

A tabulation of the records for the area indicates that monthly Social Security payments for all types of benefits are being paid to about 26,000 individuals at the rate of about \$1.7 million per month. Davis pointed out that the proceeds of benefit checks are characteristically spent immediately for food, clothes and shelter. This steady flow of more than \$20 million per year into normal trade channels provides a

strong stabilizing influence for local businesses. Davis extended an invitation to residents of the area to visit the new office or write or telephone for free booklets explaining the rights and benefits under the Social Security program. He suggested that individuals and organizations who maintain listings of service facilities in the area should note the address and telephone number since it is not included in the current telephone directory. The address is 1408 Crenshaw Blvd., telephone 320-4020.

Three more blocks of the fast diminishing unimproved street areas in the Shoestring Strip will be paved under a contract awarded this week, Councilman John S. Gibson said. Griffith Co., of Wilmington, received the award on a low bid of \$19,853 and will pave Halldale Avenue between Plaza Del Amo and 228th Street, and Denker Street between Plaza Del Amo and 227th Street. The improvement will include curb, gutters, and sidewalks. Councilman Gibson said work should commence in about three weeks.
