

School Officials Sibert, Jones Earn Doctorates in Education

Final oral examinations for the degree of doctor of education were held for James G. Sibert and Lloyd G. Jones, Torrance school personnel, by the University of Southern California Graduate School on Wednesday, Oct. 31. Formal conferring of the degree will be made at graduation exercises in June at USC.

Dr. Sibert, a former resident of Pennsylvania, served at Army Headquarters, 3rd Corps Area, Baltimore, Md., from 1940-41 and as a member of the Allied Intelligence Bureau from 1942-45. He received his bachelor's and master's degrees from the University of Southern California in 1947 and 1948.

DURING THE years of 1948-50, he was employed as Arab Personnel Specialist in Saudi Arabia. He began his teaching career in 1950 at El Segundo and in 1952 became a high school teacher in Torrance. In 1955 Dr. Sibert was appointed personnel consultant at the administrative offices of the Torrance Unified School District, where he is presently employed.

His dissertation subject was "A Comparison and Analysis of Certified Personnel Employment Policies and Related Practices in Selected Unified Districts of Southern California."

DR. JONES, a native Californian born in Riverside, graduated from Narbonne High School, attended Compton Junior College, and served in the

Special Services Division of the United States Army during the Second World War. In 1948 he received his bachelor's degree from Le Verne College and began teaching for the Torrance Unified School District. He received his master's degree from the University of Southern California in 1952 and was appointed vice principal of North Torrance Elementary School. In 1953 Dr. Jones was appointed principal of Seaside Elementary School, where he served until 1959. He is presently employed as consultant, educational services of Torrance Unified School District.
