

New Lights Ordered for Carson Area

New street lighting will brighten the neighborhood along three streets in the Carson area under an annexation program approved by the Board of Supervisors.

According to Supervisor Burton W. Chace, who supported additional lighting, seven new 4,000-lumen overhead lights will be added along portions of 235th Street, Orchard Avenue, and Figueroa Street.

The work, to be done in July, was authorized under annexation to the Dolores Lighting District as requested by tract residents.

"This tract is bordered by Figueroa Street on the east and includes 235th Street and Orchard Avenue westerly of Figueroa," the Supervisor said. All seven of the newest lights will be installed with overhead wiring by Southern California Edison Co.
