Two citizens of the Greater Southwest have been elected to high office in the 27,000-member Los Angeles County Employes Assn., it was announced yesterday.

Mrs. O'Brien was elected first vice president. Cliburn was elected second vice president.

Mrs. O'Brien, who polled the highest vote of any candidate running for a contested post, has been active in the affairs of the employe organization since she began her county service 16 years ago.

For a period of six years she has held elective office in the association, serving this year on the board of directors, as a member of several committees, and as chairman of the Public Relations Committee and vice chairman of the Publications Committee.
