Opening Audiences Delight 'Marriage Go-Round' Cast

Whoever predicted that "Marriage Go-Round" by Leslie Stevens would be a howling success was certainly clairvoyant, evidence the fact that opening weekend audiences were doing exactly that—howling at the stimulating and gay banter on stage of Chapel Theatre in Torrance. The entire production is wholly informal from the beginning, even before the curtains part when Dick Miller of Miraleste

as Professor Paul Deville welcomes his "lecture" audience. Combining the talents of the four members of the cast in "The Marriage Go-Round" makes for much merriment, according to Jarl Victor of Palos Verdes who is the director of this two-act comedy. Miller as Paul seems to have much fun with his role as the middleman of the triangle, created by Rosemary Buell of Palos Verdes as his wife, Content, and Alma Nelson, also of

Palos Verdes as Katrin the intruder of this happily married couple.

WITH MILLER'S adept ad-libbing, the cast is never quite sure of what will happen next. Considering this fact, Rosemary Buell is most capable as the patient and calm wife, waiting for the crisis created by the Swedish blond viking to be gone. Alma Nelson as Katrin is delightful, with her slight Swedish accent, fluent French and Swedish dialogue and her classic Swedish stature. As always, Larry Worch adds much to bringing calm and restraint to the conflicts which occur in the lives

of his best friends, as he portrays the family friend with the soothing influence.

Many congratulations go to Phyllis Palmer of Redondo Beach who is producer and also helped design the set with Steve Sands, resident producer. The set is designed and dressed in excellent taste adding much to the general atmosphere of this play. Also many bouquets to the crew consisting of Nich Boutakoff and Rudi Medina as stage managers, with Jon Matson doing sounds and lights.

SELECTED by local artist Robert Neathery of Redondo Beach, are the works of art exhibited in the auditorium during the entire showing of "The Marriage Go-Round." Neathery has chosen a variety of different types of works which are modern but non-
