

Academy Nominee Examination Set

Clayton A. Dills, state assemblyman, representing the 67th District, announces an examination for young men in his district to become his nominee for admission to the California Maritime Academy in August, 1963.

The examination will be held at Los Angeles City College, Room 102, Life Science Bldg., Los Angeles, 9 a.m. Monday, April 8, 1963.

There are no fees for this examination. The candidate may also take the college entrance examination board scholastic aptitude test concerning which his school counselor can provide information.

Candidates taking the scholastic aptitude test should request that a copy of the test results be sent to the academy for evaluation and notify the academy of their home address.

THE APPLICANT with the highest passing score on the test will become the nominee of Assemblyman Clayton A. Dills. Others with passing scores may be admitted if vacancies in the quota for the entering class exist.

Under the provisions of the California Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 81 of 1955, each state senator and each state assemblyman representing an odd-numbered district may nominate a young man from

his district for admission to the academy in 1963.

The state-operated California Maritime Academy is located on Carquinez Straits, Vallejo, northwest of San Francisco Bay. The academy program provides, in three years, approximately the same education as the normal four-year college.

THE GRADUATE receives a Bachelor of Science degree, either in nautical science or in marine engineering and is licensed by the U. S. Coast Guard as an officer for service aboard U. S. Merchant ships.

Those who are physically and otherwise qualified, are eligible for commissions in the U. S. Naval Reserve.

Students must pay certain fees which include room and board, and must purchase their textbooks and uniforms.

To be eligible for admission, an applicant must, at the time of admission on Aug. 12, 1963, be a high school graduate, unmarried, 17 years of age but not yet 22, and meet certain physical and mental requirements.
