Harbor College student Nathan Smith, 26426 Ozone Ave., Harbor City, this week was named winner of the \$150 first prize in the Highway Safety essay contest sponsored by the

Wilmington-San Pedro Insurance Assn.

Presentation of the award was made at the Harbor's awards assembly by Denver Bullock, president of the sponsoring association.

Reports Diseases

SIMTH'S ESSAY, "A Good Defense — The Best Offense," was concerned with the fact that drivers under 25 years of age, while accounting for 14

per cent of the population are responsible for 27 per cent of the accidents.

The essay blamed this on the poor driving habits — that people lapse into. The unconscious carelessness causes the normally law-abiding citizen to have accidents.

Smith suggests that drivers develop the art of defensive driving based on two concepts: first, the majority of accidents are preventable; second by avoiding accident provoking situations and heeding warning signs, the dangers of accidents can be lessened.

To Study Recent Advances In Chemistry Under Grant

James A. Campbell, member of the chemistry faculty of El Camino College, has been awarded a National Science Foundation Science Faculty Fellowship for the 1963-64 academic year.

Campbell will study recent advances in inorganic, organic and physical chemistry at the University of Southern California during the term of his grant. He will also continue research work started at USC under a National Science Foundation Summer Research Participation Grant in 1959.

NATIONAL SCIENCE Foundation Faculty Fellowships are offered as a means of providing an opportunity to finance faculty members so that they might increase their competence in their specialized fields of knowledge, or broaden their scope in related fields.

The award consists of paying the instructor's salary for one year and allowing him to study in the graduate school of his choice during that time.

Campbell is the third El Camino chemistry faculty member to receive this fellowship. Dr. Robert Long returned to the campus this year after a year's study at the California Institute of Technology, and Dr. Jack Hileman spent the 1960-61 year studying at the University of California at Los Angeles under this grant.

A RESIDENT of Los Angeles, Campbell has served as president of the California Science Teachers' Assn., southern section, and last year was selected as one of two instruc-
