Prenatal Care Available At Avalon Village Center

Medical care for pregnant women who cannot afford private supervision is now available from the Los Angeles County Health Department at its Avalon Village facilities on 231st Street near Avalon Boulevard, reported Dr. P. R. Auriemma, district health officer. The new service is an addition to the child health conferences or "baby clinics" held at the health center.

Appointments for prenatal care must be made in advance by calling NEwKirk 9-6010, ext. 333. Prospective patients are asked to make their first contact by telephone.

THE MEDICAL and health supervision of pregnant women provided by the Los Angeles County Health Department includes the services of the physician, public health nurse and social caseworker.

A volunteer from the local community, Mrs. William Doyle, 515 E. 238th Place, Wilmington, assists the professional staff and patients as needed.

Physical examinations, diagnostic tests and health instructions are given by a licensed obstetrician.

Mothers-to-be are instructed by the public health nurse on such subjects as hygiene of pregnancy, labor and childbirth, care of the newborn infant, layettes, infant baths and formula preparation.
