Three Air Force Academy Cadets South High Grads

In the shadow of the famed Pike's Peak lies the nation's newest service academy, the United States Air Force Academy.

The young men who graduate from the Air Force Academy have to be extremely well qualified both scholastically and physically. They must have their sights set on the future and be willing to work hard toward their goals as efficient Air Force officers. Three such young men have been qualified from South High School in Torrance.

Cadet Michael R. Robbins, a 1960 graduate of South High School, is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Richard H. Robbins of Arlington Heights, Illinois, formerly of Torrance. A former Boy Scout and student body president, he lettered in football three years, golf one year and participated on the varsity track team at South High School.

AT GRADUATION he was honored by the Bank of America's "Most Outstanding Student" Award and Athletic-Scholarship Award and has a lifetime membership in the Scholarship Society. Cadet Robbins, who is a second classman (junior) at the Academy has made an equally outstanding record here.

He has participated on the boxing, soccer, and pistol varsity teams in addition to being a member of the Model Engineering Club, Radio Club and Rally Committee. The Superintendent's Merit List, an honor awarded only to cadets who are outstanding in both academic and military studies, has claimed Cadet Robbins for four semesters.

CADET JOHN A. Hewitt Jr., a 1961 graduate of South High School and the son of Col. and Mrs. John A. Hewitt, presently of Colton, is a member of the Class of 1965. He earned three letters from the varsity golf

team and served as a member of the Student Government at South.

Much of his energies have been put into the Boy Scout program where he attained the ranks of Eagle and Ace scout. While attending high school, Cadet Hewitt was enrolled in a course at El Camino Junior College.

Upon his graduation from South High he was awarded a scholarship to the University of Pennsylvania and received the Athletic-Scholarship Award in addition to being a member of the National Honor Society.

AT THE ACADEMY, Cadet Hewitt has lettered in golf and was on the Dean's List for one semester for excellence in academics. He is currently participating in the enrichment program where his major is International Relations.

Cadet William R. Latham III, son of Lt. Col. and Mrs. W. R. Latham, Jr., of Rialto, is a 1962 graduate of South High School in Torrance. While in high school he lettered in football and baseball and participated in track. He was also active in the Boy Scout program. For three semesters he was a member of the California Scholarship Federation. At the Academy he has participated in soccer and the Ski Club, Dance Committee and is currently majoring in Military Management in the academic enrichment program.
