

Thousands of little girls in brown uniforms and their older sisters in green uniforms are approaching shoppers and ringing doorbells today with the question, "Would you like to buy some cookies?" during the Cookie Sale of Girl Scouts, Los Angeles Council.

Proceeds from the sale, which last through Feb. 22, will provide funds for over half of the expenses of administering Girl Scouts, Los Angeles Council. General operating expenses, including an extensive training program for the 20,000 adult volunteers, registration expenses, program aides, audio-visual material, camp upkeep, office supplies, staff salaries, and all other costs necessary for bringing Scouting to 31,000 girls, are partially defrayed by profits from the sale.

Los Angeles Council extends from San Pedro through San Fernando Valley, and from Downey through Brentwood.
