Iowa Solon To Address Area Group

Jack Miller, Republican senator from Iowa, will speak at a special political forum sponsored by the South Bay Young Republican Club tonight at the Fish Shanty Restaurant located on Pacific Coast Highway near Hawthorne Boulevard.

Senator Miller, elected to his present office in 1960, defeated two-term Democratic Governor Herschel Lovell in the November senatorial race. Miller is currently a member of the Senate committees on Interior and Insular Affairs, Public Works and the District of Columbia.

A TAX LAWYER and farm tax writer by profession, he formerly served as an attorney in the Office of the Chief Counsel, Internal Revenue Service, Washington, D.C.

He has lectured before numerous legal, accounting, trade and business groups on various tax subjects in twenty states and the District of Columbia, and his articles on taxation have been published in many legal and tax periodicals and most of the nation's leading farm journals.

Miller served as a lecturer on taxation on the faculty of the George Washington University department of business administration in 1948 and as an assistant professor of law at the University of Notre Dame College of Law 1948-1949. He is co-author of the Prentice-Hall Tax Ideas Service and formerly served on the board of editors of the Journal of Taxation.

MILLER BEGAN his public service as a member of the Iowa House of Representatives where he served from 1955 to 1956. He was then elected to a four-year term in the Iowa Senate where he served until his election to the U.S. Senate in 1960.

"The appearance of Senator Jack Miller, an articulate young Republican on the Washington scene, is another example of the outstanding speakers brought to the Southwest by the South Bay Young Republican Club," Clarence "Bus" Turner, president of the club, stated today. Garden Checklist

1. Set out summer blooming bulbs such as cannas, gladiolus, watsonias and tigridias.
2. Begonia tubers should be started in flats of peat and leaf mold. Keep them under cover until all danger of frost is past.
3. Sow seed of stock, snapdragon and other annuals for summer.
4. Plant clumps of delphinium and primrose. Well established plants are available in nurseries during late February and early March.
5. You can still plant roses bareroot. Don't delay too much longer, however.
