Bradbury Stories in 2-Million-Plus Books

How adventuresome are you? Do you feel like balancing on the edge of a cliff? Or do you think you could take it if you were shoved off?

You can experience either or both, figuratively speaking of course, by rushing to the El Retiro Library, at 126-A Vista del Parque, El Retiro Park, and putting in your bid for the two latest books by Ray Bradbury. Both volumes were recently added to the high county library's 2-million-plus book collection.

The books are "R Is for Rocket," which was the county library system's 2-millionth book, and "Something Wicked This Way Comes," Bradbury's first full-length fantasy novel, which the library bought a few weeks before it reached the 2-millionth milestone.

MRS. FRANCES Zinsley, the El Retiro librarian, said it is Bradbury who describes science-fiction as "balancing one on the edge of a cliff" and fantasy as "shoving one off." He also said that science-fiction obeys the laws of the universe and that fantasy, "which emphasizes the IM in 'impossible' cracks the universe wide open."

There is a waiting list for both books Mrs. Zinsley said, suggesting the anxious reader get his name on that list at once, since the sooner he does the less time he will have to wait.

Every science-fiction fan, and the number is increasing daily, knows Bradbury's books and stories. They have been translated into 20 different languages and new tales from his imaginative mind appears frequently in many different magazines.

When the book is published, the El Retiro Library will have

of Bradbury is through the pages of the "Reader's Guide to Periodical Literature" both current and old editions. Since the county library subscribes to more than 700 magazines and has back issues extending over the years, Bradbury stories old and new can easily be tracked down and obtained.

A Bradbury article that none of his readers will want to miss was published last October in the "Take-Over Generation" of Life Magazine, librarian Mrs. Zinsley said, and is available, as are all of the county library's magazine and books, to every patron of every branch.

Many anthologies of science-fiction have introductions by Bradbury which give new meaning and understanding to all science-fiction and fantasy writing. The county library ordered one such collection this week, "Timeless Stories for Today and Tomorrow," a paperback book.

ALSO ON ORDER is a new translation of Jules Verne's "20,000 Leagues Under the Sea," which is made doubly interesting by an introduction written especially for it by Bradbury. This book is also a paperback.

At a public meeting celebrating the library's acquisition of its 2-millionth book, held Jan. 21 in the County Hall of Administration in Los Angeles, at which Bradbury was the principal speaker, he told about a novel he is now writing based on a weird and wonderful world he has imagined as existing inside the telephone.



In making the announcement Fr. Pekarok quoted Arthur S. Marmaduke, executive director of the State Scholarship Commission, who said in his letter: "The Commission wishes to point out that all the semi-finalist students have achieved a marked level of success on the competitive examination and deserve commendation for this demonstration of academic ability."

Harbor Dean Appointed to City College

Dr. Robert V. Bacon, assistant dean of the evening division of Harbor College, has been appointed acting dean of the evening division of Los Angeles City College, it was announced here by Wendell C. Black, Harbor College president.

Dr. Bacon, who lives at 44 Bucksline Lane, Rolling Hills Estates, will go to his new post Thursday. He has been at Harbor College since 1950, first teaching business administration and then serving as coordinator of public relations, coordinator of admissions and acting assistant dean of the evening division.

At Los Angeles City College Dr. Bacon will be serving in the largest junior college in the United States. LACC has an enrollment of 8,000 day and 8,000 evening students. This large enrollment in the evening division requires a faculty of 410 instructors compared to the 120 in the Harbor College evening program.

Dr. Bacon earned a bachelor's and master's degree and a doctorate in education at UCLA.
