DR. BANKS has been invited by the University of Colorado to teach two five-week summer session courses in British drama. While there, he will direct Shakespeare's "Much Ado About Nothing" for the Colorado Shakespeare Festival.

In the summer session of 1959 and 1961, Dr. Banks directed "A Midsummer Night's Dream" and "Henry V" for the nationally-recognized festival.

Recently, Dr. Banks was made a charter member and advisor to the newly-formed Playwright's Community Theater of Gardena for his contribution to the formation of this new theater development.

In the current production, "The Merchant of Venice," Dr. Banks will again use the Globe Playhouse stage as designed by Les Thomas, technical director for the theater. To follow further the Shakespearean atmosphere, costuming will be patterned after the original attire worn by Shakespearean actors in the 16th Century.
