## Tiki Tabu Builder Executive Director

Dan Ostrow, builder of Tiki Tabu in Torrance, has been appointed executive director in charge of all apartment projects for the R. A. Watt Construction and its subsidiaries.

In his new post, the former Washington D. C. and Tahiti builder will serve as an affiliate with the Gardena-based construction firm which annually builds more than 200 units throughout the state.

For the past year Ostrow has supervised all on and off site activities of the apartment division. He currently is building five major apartment projects of over 200 units in Redondo, Bellflower, Lompop, Orange and Gardena.

One of his most successful projects, the colorful Tiki Tabu opened early this year and already is filled to capacity. The Tiki Tabu is patterned after the Tahiti Village and Iorania Hotel in the town of Papeete on the island of Tahiti which Ostrow built during his recent

two-year stay in the South Pacific.

Prior to his Tahitian adventure, the former college footballer built more than 1,000 homes in Washington, D. C., and Maryland area. He lives in Westwood with wife Jeanette, a native of Tahiti.
