

## Expert Presents Six Suggestions For Earthquakes

Six suggestions for the community to follow in gearing for a possible earthquake have been issued by an expert in the field.

Dr. Charles Richter of Cal Tech says, "As in all disasters, do not panic, do not run, do not congest the streets and roads with cars, keep away from disaster areas unless on relief business, do not make unnecessary telephone calls and do not repeat alarming stories even if they seem to come from a reliable source."

Dr. Richter explained that active faults are distributed over the whole Southern California region and "there is no settled community in California which is not more or less exposed to such risk."

be directed to removal of risks. Old and unsafe buildings, public and private, should be reinforced or replaced. The risk varies chiefly with the foundation, being least on sound rock. After the earth starts shaking an individual can do little," he said.

The earthquake expert made his suggestions after being asked for them by Supervisor Kenneth Hahn who has asked the County Civil Defense Commission to use Dr. Richter's suggestions and advice as the basis for an educational program.


