## All-Beethoven Program Selected for Recital

For his fifth consecutive year, Dr. Robert Haag of the El Camino College music department, will perform in a piano recital on the Warrior campus. Dr. Haag will appear in the Campus Theater tomorrow at 8:30 p.m.

Under the sponsorship of the Associated Students and the Division of Fine Arts, the program will be open to the public without charge.

Dr. Haag joined the El Camino staff eight years ago and has taught classes in music, music history, theory, and piano. Shortly after he assumed his duties at the college, he took a leave of absence to complete a two-year tour of duty with the Armed Services.

A native of California, Dr. Haag attended Bakersfield City College before transferring to the University of California at Los Angeles. He took his bachelor of arts degree at UCLA and then returned to the campus for his master of arts doctor of philosophy degrees.

The all-Beethoven program for his performance will include Sonata in C Minor, Opus 13; Sonata in G Major, Opus 31, No. 1; the Sonata in E Flat Major, Opus 31, No. 3; and Sonata in C Minor, Opus 111.

In addition to the El Camino recital, Dr. Haag has already performed at Pasadena City College, and will present programs at UCLA Oct. 29, and at Los Angeles Valley College Nov. 5.

## Top Entertainers Slated For Porpoise Room Shows

Embarking upon its most imposing entertainment schedule since inaugurating its present "top-name" policy in 1957, the Marineland Restaurant in Palos Verdes announces seven important musical attractions have been slated to headline in the "Porpoise Room" between now and next summer.

All of the talent, according to owner George M. Foster, who also books the entertainment, appeared here before, having played to capacity audiences during every return engagement.

A COMING attractions guide just released by Foster reflects the most star-studded program in Marineland Restaurant's six-year history of presenting dinner-supper shows. The 1963-64 bill in the "Porpoise Room" has burgeoned from modest piano music and instrumental duos to its current slate of celebrated bands and music-comedy artists. This top-talent policy, launched in 1957 with the Bernie Jones Four, transformed the restaurant into a major after-dark "supper club"-type operation.

Another hilarious song-&-fun group, the Bernie Jones Quartet, open Nov. 26 and continue through Jan. 5 of 1964. Big Tiny Little, his honky-tonk piano and ragtime band, headline Jan. 28 and perform through Mar. 15, with the king of the banjo, Eddie Peabody, returning from Mar. 17 through April 12.

The Ink Spots are scheduled from April 14 through May 24.

Mexico's colorful singing mariachi band, The Aquilas, open May 26 and topline through July 5.

Reservations in the "Porpoise Room" especially on all week-ends, are advised by Foster and general-manager Berk MacPherson.
