**El Segundo Hosts Tartars In Pioneer League Finale**

Attempting to salvage a dismal football campaign, one-time winner Torrance High will close out its Pioneer League season tomorrow night against El Segundo. Everything was rosy for Torrance last year when it picked up the league championship, but this time around, the Tartars can boast of only a 7-6 triumph over cross-town rival West High.

A PIONEER LEAGUE title threat at the beginning of the year, El Segundo is now out of the championship picture but

**'B' Squad At North Eyes Title**

Torrance's only undefeated high school football team will attempt to cinch a Sky League championship tomorrow afternoon. With eight straight wins to its credit, North High's "B" football team will engage Leuzinger tomorrow at 3 p.m. on the Saxon turf in the final circuit campaign of the season.

UNDER THE coaching of Curt Curtiss and Jim O'Brien, the Saxons have tallied 174 points and allowed their opponents only 27. In competition with other city teams, North handed South a 7-0 licking and edged Torrance, 13-6.

Curtiss gives the credit for North's success to experience. Veterans abound in the tough Saxon defense where ends Gary Martin and Paul Romero, middle linebacker Tex Dearing, middle guard Mike Tuffley, tackle Art Ewert, and line-backers Rollie Bell and Joe Silva put up an impenetrable front.

SO FAR, no eleven has managed a long scoring drive against North and only one team has managed a touchdown in the first half.

Offensively, the middle of the line is North's strongest point, according to Curtiss. Center Tim Ramsey and guards Greg Winterbottom and Mike Mooko bulwark the middle.

IN THE backfield, Curtiss will open with quarterback Henry Lopez, sophomore full-back Steve Schmitz, and half-backs Joe Montensen and Norm Sanwo.

Mortenson scored four touchdowns in North's romp over Inglewood but Curtiss feels Schmitz is a prime varsity candidate.

**West Meets Unbeaten Birds**

If West High was surprised by Lawndale's performance last week, the Warriors will know for sure what they are getting into tomorrow night at Aviation in the final Pioneer League game of the year. Lawndale, the surprise team in the league, ran roughshod over West Saturday night to grab a 37-13 decision. After the game, Warrior mentor Bill Parton said, "They were much better than I thought. They were the best team we have met all year."

THERE ARE no doubts in Parton's mind about the quality of team Aviation will bring out. The Falcons are unbeaten and only a 13-13 tie with Lawndale mars a perfect season record. Operating without its all-league halfback Joe Burton, Aviation remained on the championship trail last week with a 12-0 triumph over Torrance. Burton left the game in the second period with a torn knee ligament.

FILMS OF THE game show Burton's knee was severely twisted, but after the game Aviation coach Ed Hyde indicated he did not think the injury was serious. Burton has been playing in recent games with a weak knee and it has not bothered him.

Against Torrance, the senior sensation returned a punt 62 yards for a touchdown to give Aviation its first score of the night.

ALTHOUGH ILL with the flu, junior fullback Bob Vroman continued his personal war on enemy lines, cranking for 45 yards in seven carries

and scoring one touchdown against Lawndale. Vroman rammed over for the first Warrior score in the third quarter, banging across from the nine-yard line to end a 60 yard march. The key play in the drive was a short pass from Lindy Nuzzo to end John Cochran, who lateraled to halfback Fred Schwanbeck.

SCHWANBECK picked up 40 yards after taking the lateral. In the final period, the same lateral play set up the second Redskin score. This time Ed Cherrier was on the receiving end of the lateral and he picked up 25 yards. Nuzzo flipped a five yard look-in pass to Cochran for the touchdown.
