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## MTA Plan Proposed By Bonelli

Supervisor Frank G. Bonelli has proposed a plan for the reconstruction of the Metropolitan Transit Authority, giving broad, countywide participation to the MTA. Bonelli proposed that an 80-member board of directors be established, with each city in the county having one representative appointed by the city councils. Two county supervisors and five additional Los Angeles city councilmen would complete the board. An executive board, representing the nine existing superior court regions was also proposed. Two supervisors would bring the executive board's membership to 11 members. BONELLI SAID the directors from the county's incorporated cities would be concilmen, giving the board a membership which is elected. All local governments would be represented under the Bonelli plan. In proposing the reconstruction of the MTA, Bonelli asked the Assembly interim committee on transportation and commerce to begin work-
