



**'Devil's Advocate' Emotional Drama**

In "The Devil's Advocate," current production at the Chapel Theater, Monsignor Meredith is assigned a double-purposed mission in a small Italian village by Cardinal Marotta, who describes him as a man who "has never loved a woman, hated a man, or pitied a child."  
 The cardinal hopes Monsignor Meredith, who is facing imminent death, will find peace while working with people during his investigation of Giacomo, a man under consideration by the Catholic Church for beatification.  
 THROUGH HIS contacts with Dr. Aldo Meyer, village doctor and only Jew in the area; Nina Sanduzzi, who is called the "Saint's whore" by the villagers; Nicholas Black, a homosexual artist; Contessa De Sanctis; a woman "with a flame no man put out;" and Paolo Sanduzzi, the saint's bastard son; the Monsignor traces the life and work of Giacomo Nerone, who lived in the village during World War II, and also solves his personal anxiety.  
 The drama, adapted by Dore Schary from the Morris L. West novel, was directed by Gladys Manu with set design by Steve Sands. Miss Manu and Sands were presented with extreme problems in this production because of the many rapid transitions from present to past. Through their efforts the scene changes were highly effective and smooth in performance.  
 Maxine Dessau was particularly superb as Nina Sanduzzi. Tom Lowry, as the dying Monsignor; Fred J. West, the Jewish doctor; Lyle Smith, the artist; Margie True, the confused contessa; and Ed Gangel the man the villagers had killed and wished to sanctify; gave realistic and highly creditable performances.  
 STRONG support was provided by Noel Shire, as Paolo Sanduzzi, Dennis Morgan, Il Lupo; Rudi Medina, Father Anselmo; and Jack Daly, Bishop Aurelio.  
 Other cast members included Walter Reese, Connie Polack and Jim Sena.
