

El Camino Musical Tickets Will Go on Sale April 16

Tickets for El Camino's early May spring musical, "Annie Get Your Gun," will go on sale Tuesday, April 16, in the student store.

The Broadway musical will be presented at 8:30 p.m. on May 2-4 and 8-11 in the Campus Theater.

Songs such as "Doing What Comes Naturally," "Lost in His Arms," "The Girl That I Marry," and "You Can't Get a Man With a Gun" will be featured in the performance.

Set construction is under the direction of Les Thomas, who will head the largest stage production ever to be presented at El Camino.

COMPOSED of 10 sets, the show features the largest individual stage ever constructed on campus. It is a reproduction of a hotel just outside of Cincinnati and measures 26 feet wide and 18 feet high.

Students James Wilson and James Boughton are assisting Thomas. Wilson has designed the lighting system while Boughton is in charge of all scene changes.

The story of Annie Oakley, female sharpshooter for a wild west show, centers around her love for Frank Butler. Barbara D'Agosta portrays the lead role of Annie and Gary Pagett plays the part of Frank Butler.

Other cast members are Kathy Sweeney, Virginia Niquette, Adison Loomis, Bob Holm, John Lindesmith, and Danny Ford. William Zimmerman, Delano Cowan, and Ken May are also featured in the cast.

BURNETT FERGUSON is directing the show and Ron Quint is the assisting director. Choreographer is Mrs. Ruth Beadles, instructor, and the musical director is Dr. Robert Haag of the music department. Sixteen dancers will perform

two major dances and four production numbers during the show.
