



**CALIFORNIA FRUIT SUNDAE** ← Good Idea!

- 1 can (1 lb. 1 oz.) fruit cocktail
- 5 orange slices (1/2 orange)
- 1 stick cinnamon
- 2 teaspoons cornstarch
- 1 tablespoon water

Drain syrup from fruit cocktail into saucepan. Cut orange slices into halves and add, with cinnamon and salt. Simmer 5 minutes. Mix cornstarch and water; stir into syrup mixture. Cook and stir until thickened and clear. Add fruit cocktail and heat. Serve over ice cream balls.
