CAMINO HOSTS METRO TRACK POWER

Staggering toward the end of a hazardous season, El Camino tracksters host Long Beach City College tomorrow afternoon with the first event scheduled for 2:30. Long Beach is securely implanted atop the conference standings with a 5-0 record, while the Warriors will carry a 1-4 mark into the dual meet. El Camino closes out its 1963 schedule Tuesday at San Diego City College.

THE LONG BEACH-El Camino encounter will bring together a star-studded galaxy of top Metropolitan Conference performers. Long Beach's Tim Russell will be pitted against the Warriors' Dennis Jett in the 100 and 220-yard sprints. **RUSSELL HAS** stepped off wind-aided clockings of 9.4 and 19.8 this season, while Jett boasts top efforts of 9.5 and

20.2, also aided by a 25-mph wind. Terry Hendrix moved into the track spotlight April 5 when he raced to a 23.5 clocking in the 220-yard low hurdles, top mark in the state this year. **THE VIKINGS** also claim one of the strongest field event caravans in the conference, headed by Johnny Rambo and Bill Pace. "Long John," as Rambo is

known in the circuit, gained national stature and pushed aside widely heralded Otis Burrell by high jumping over 6 ft. 10 in. in the past two weeks. He cleared 6-10 3/4 against East Los Angeles and 6-10 1/4 at the Southern California JC Relays, April 11. **PACE HAS** been breaking jaycee shot put marks with ease this year and has a 56-11 1/2" shot put.

Outstanding entrants for the Warriors will be distance runners Rich Fernandez, Kurt Klein and Don Griffie, plus sprinters Pat Lininger, Bill Johnson, Les Hayes and Jett. **FERNANDEZ**, 1962 conference cross country champion, suffered his first shut-out of the year April 5, when he was

keyed by Valley's Dick Krenzer. The spindly sophomore will be entered in the mile and two-mile events. Griffie, according to coach Ray Southstone, has the ability to become one of the top runners in El Camino history, a high compliment considering the presence of record-breaker Mike Thornton in Warrior track annals. **KLEIN** and Lininger will be slim favorites in the 880 and 440-yard events, while Hayes and Johnson will be among the Tribe's undefeated mile relay quartet. One unblemished record is bound to topple, with both LBCC's and the Warriors' relay ensembles possessing perfect conference winning skeins.
