

**THE SUPERINTENDENT** denied any liability: He was just a fellow employee. He had no duty to look after Joe's safety. But the court ruled for Joe. True, an equal co-worker has no duties to look out for his fellow worker, but Jones was more than a co-worker; he was a superintendent.

A superintendent has a legal duty to see to the workers' safety. He has control over a project and the machinery used. The court ruled that this superintendent was personally liable to workers assigned to work on a dangerous machine, especially when the worker was not aware of its dangers.

Law suits by workers against their employer for job injuries have been rare, since workmen's compensation covers the worker satisfactorily as a rule. For in such cases he needs only show that the accident happened in connection with the job for him to
