

Bank Names Winners of Competition

Six high school seniors from Torrance were named winners in the Bank of America's annual Achievement Awards program following competition at the Inglewood Elks Club, April 17.

Sherlyn Lea Farmer, vocational arts, of South High School, and Elias Baumgarten, liberal arts, of North High School won first place.

THEY ARE eligible for the final competition to be held May 15 at the Statler Hilton Hotel, Los Angeles, which will be attended by top ranking students from 68 schools in the southern part of the county. Participants will receive a minimum prize of \$150 each with a chance at \$1000 awards in the \$98,100 statewide program.


