Rancho San Antonio Issues Open Invitation to Fiesta

The public is invited to attend the 14th annual barbecue and fiesta at Rancho San Antonio, California's "Boys Town of the West," located at 21000 Plummer St., Chatsworth, which will be held Sunday.

The rancho, under the sponsorship of the Southern California Knights of Columbus, has restored approximately 2,500 misdirected boys of all races, creeds, and national origins, to good citizenship.

The celebration Sunday finalizes a two-month drive for funds headed by Dick Joosten, local council chairman, for the further development of the rancho, according to Frank Paluch, grand knight of St. Gerard Council 4919. This local unit of the order, together with more than 90 other councils has been actively engaged in this drive, which is the Knights' one-a-year effort for their principal charity project.

There will be no admission charge to the barbecue and fiesta. The rancho is equipped to serve more than 15,000 dinners. Boys residing at the rancho will conduct guided tours through the buildings and over the 40-acre site. A fun zone, highlighted by a giant spaceship which takes off on an imaginary flight to the moon, will be set up for the kiddies.

Serving hours will be from 11:30 a.m. to 8 p.m. The rancho is reached by taking the Ventura freeway to the Winnetka Avenue turn-off, then following posted directional signs.


