

Citizens Volunteer to Head '53 Minute March'

Three Torrance citizens will head the annual May appeal of the United Cerebral Palsy Assn. in this community. Mike Kasino, 1348 El Prado will serve as Torrance com-

unity chairman and Mrs. James R. Cantrell, 3130 West 187th St., as residential chairman. Mrs. W. A. Huber, 5408 Rockview Dr., will assist Kasino with the business and industry phase of the campaign, and also work as an area leader in the residential campaign. In their capacities as leaders of the Torrance appeal, Kasino, Mrs. Cantrell and Mrs. Huber will direct the area's share of the UCP drive for funds to aid those handicapped by cerebral palsy. They will be assisted by neighborhood leaders and block workers whose recruitment is now under way.

KASINO, manager of Kay's Men's Shop, is active in civic affairs. Mrs. Cantrell has many interests, including the South Bay Mothers of Twins Club. Mrs. Huber, of the Alyce O'Rourke Realty Co., has served in previous UCPA campaigns, and has been community chairman in the past. She is a Blue Bird leader.

More than 17,000 children and adults in Los Angeles County have cerebral palsy, Kasino points out.

"Cerebral palsy results from damage to the motor areas of the brain, the areas which 'give orders' to your muscles," Kasino explains. "It isn't a disease and it isn't hereditary. Rehabilitation is costly, for it takes long training and therapy."

The United Cerebral Palsy Assn. maintains four nurseries for pre-school children from 1 1/2 to 3, three development centers for children 3 to 16, an industrial training workshop, provides occupational therapy training and extensive counseling facilities.

SERVING the South Bay area is United Cerebral Palsy's pre-school nursery at 4031 Wilton St., Long Beach.

To be called the "53 Minute March," the May appeal will emphasize that a child with cerebral palsy is born every 53 minutes.

Volunteer workers are needed urgently for the campaign, Kasino said. He asked that those willing to help, telephone 925-3380.




