

International Trade Fair Under Way in Long Beach

The biggest international trade fair in Southern California history is under way in the \$8 million Long Beach Arena.

Merchandise and manufactures of 30 nations are on display and theme of the 10-day show is "Department Store of the World."

Called the International Trade Fair-West, the exposition is one of three big world trade shows to be held in the U. S. and forerunner of regular annual trade events in Long Beach.

Similar expositions are to be held for the midwest in Chicago and for the east in New York.

FAIR OFFICIALS hope for an attendance of between 50,000 and 100,000 persons.

"We have a terrific show and one we believe should be of interest to the customer as well as people in the merchandising industry," explains Fred Jones, fair administrator.

In addition to trade exhibits there will be displays by foreign governments, overseas airlines, the U. S. Department of Commerce and Customs service and nightly entertainment including an appearance of the famed 44-member United Nations Boys Choir.

The fair is being held in conjunction with the national and regional celebration of World Trade Week.

NATIONS with exhibits include Japan, China, India, Pakistan, Israel, Spain, Italy, the

U. S., England, France, Sweden, Mexico, Peru, Brazil, West Germany, Argentina, Austria, Ireland, Tahiti, Korea, South Africa and Norway.

One of the most spectacular exhibits will be the French Pavilion which, in addition to fine manufacturers, foodstuffs and wines, will be graced by three beautiful Tahitian native dancing girls, all of whom appeared in the motion picture "Mutiny on the Bounty."

THE PUBLIC will be able to buy some pretty unusual and

exotic items including replica Aztec stone calendars from Mexico, smoked pheasant, paintings, camel saddles, teaching machines, Italian hairpieces, and objects de culture and art from all parts of Asia, Europe, North America, and Africa.

Among other manufacturers are the jet-stream driven boat, "Whottawhip," the type of craft Jackie Kennedy uses to water ski, the French racing bikes which have won the world famed Tours de France international bicycle race for the past

three years in a row and almost anything a "Department Store of the World" would stock including housewares, handcrafts, gift items, textiles, clothing, foodstuffs, sporting equipment, marine products, musical electronic equipment, and jewelry.

IN ADDITION to the general public, buyers and retail store executives from throughout the western U. S. will attend the exposition which runs through Sunday.

"We are highly gratified

with the success of this show and are assured that even bigger regional trade fairs will be held in Long Beach in future years," explains Jones.

Week days the fair will be open to the public from 2 to 10 p.m. and on Sunday from 11 a.m. to 10 p.m. Adult admission is \$1, children under 12 and servicemen 50 cents.

Fair officials said a grand prize will be given away during the fair. The prize, as yet unannounced, will probably be a vacation trip to some exotic spot in the world.
