### Senator Cites Basic Flaw In Assessing Castro's Cuba

Senator Clair Engle (D-Calif.) said today that a "fundamental flaw" in U.S. Cuban intelligence prior to the October crisis of last year was the assumption that Soviet strategy would never call for offensive missiles in Cuba.

"This erroneous assumption was pointed out in the report issued recently by the Senate Preparedness Subcommittee," Senator Engle said. "The Subcommittee, I believe, was thorough, fair and objective in analyzing the Cuban military buildup. They demonstrated that on the whole the intelligence operation of this country turned in a creditable job."

"BUT OUR intelligence people were operating on the premise that the Soviets would never set up offensive missiles in the Caribbean. The premise, of course, proved to be a fundamental flaw in the intelligence-gathering effort."

Senator Engle said the Subcommittee — part of the Senate Armed Services Committee — investigated the essential U.S. "intelligence community" which includes the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) and the

intelligence facilities of the Army, the Navy and the Air Force.

Senator Engle said the Subcommittee was able to settle on an estimate of 17,500 Soviet troops still in Cuba.

"THESE TROOPS are in Cuba for three reasons," the California lawmaker said.

"First, to control Mr. Castro; second, to provide military training for the Cubans; and, finally, to train the Cubans to export subversion, revolution and Communism in South America."

Senator Engle said the threat of serious Red inroads in strife-torn Haiti is widened by a lack of interest by the Organization of American States (OAS).

Senator Engle supported J. William Fulbright (D-Ark.), chairman of the Senate Foreign Relations Committee, in criticizing the OAS for not assuming a more vigorous policy regarding Caribbean trouble spots, as exemplified in Cuba and Haiti.

Senator Engle made the remarks in a television interview.
