### Dr. Smith Cited for YMCA Work

Dr. Rollin R. Smith, 2682 Harbor Sight Dr., Palos Verdes Estates, a board member of the Torrance YMCA for 15 years, Monday night received the Los Angeles YMCA's highest honor at the organization's 81st annual meeting at the Biltmore Bowl.

His name was entered in the Golden Book of Distinguished Service, an honor reserved for men whose "service to youth through the YMCA has been distinguished by length, intensity, devotion and significant accomplishment."

DR. SMITH was the first person from the Torrance Y ever to be so honored. Herbert Powell, member of the Los Angeles YMCA Board of Directors read the citation and presented Dr. Smith with a framed copy before more than 900 people representing 26 branches.

Dr. Smith, a Hi-Y boy as a youth in Colorado and active in the Hollywood Y as a young man, was cited for his 15 years service to Torrance.

The group received the Chairman's Trophy in recognition of its attaining the highest percentage of increase over the previous year's fund drive production among 26 Y branches.

Dr. Allen L. Pyeatt and Dr. Wing Y. Mar accepted the award, which was presented by John S. Schumann, a member of the campaign policy committee.

The Torrance Y raised \$11,000 more than in the previous year, and is within \$600 of its \$50,000 goal.
