The new camp, for girls, will open July 13 at Camp Mozumdar near Crestline for an eight-day session.

Camp Mozumdar will be limited to girls between nine and 13 years of age. In recent years, the campsite has not been used by the local group because of its limited size. An overflow of 50 girls at Camp Big Pines necessitated the new camp session.

The camp has a lodge and dining, a heated swimming pool, archery and handicraft centers, mountain trails, an outdoor chapel, and a campfire circle.

Other Torrance YMCA camps are filling rapidly, with the next scheduled groups to leave July 13. Four groups will depart on the 13th, and a group now on the Colorado will return soon.
