persons in their 70's now serving among the 5,000 volunteers stationed in 45 nations. Married couples may qualify if they have no dependents and if both husband and wife qualify for the same project.

Volunteers agree to serve two years in the corps, including training time.

APPLICANTS selected will spend 10 to 12 weeks on a college campus or at a Peace Corps camp in Puerto Rico, studying the language, history and culture of their host country, and American affairs.

Persons with a liberal arts background or skills in agriculture, public health, forestry, carpentry and other building skills, social work, and education of all types and at all levels are particularly qualified for the program. Nations have asked the Peace Corps to provide volunteers possessing more than 200 job skills. A college degree is not required.

The corps pays all of a volunteer's expenses and furnishes administrative support to him abroad. He also receives at the completion of his service, a readjustment allowance of \$75 for each month of satisfactory service.

Aerona Awarded Contract

A second prime contract of more than \$1 million to construct an additional large tracking antenna system has been awarded Aerona Manufacturing Corp.

The contract was received from the office of Naval Research which a few weeks ago, awarded Aerona a similar contract for \$1,846,000. The new award is for \$1,128,983 for a total program of nearly \$2,973,000 to design, build and erect two complete systems for the Navy.

The 60-foot Cassegrain double reflector antennas will be placed on large towers to be erected by Aerona at Waldorf, Maryland, and La Posta, Calif. According to S. J. Kuderer, Aerona's president, to achieve the high accuracy required, the reflector portions of the system will be constructed of bonded honeycomb aluminum panels with the production of the large dishes to be done in the Middletown, Ohio plant. All work will start immediately, he said.

These particular antenna systems will be used for space communications studies leading to the development of advanced equipment design expected to provide new operational capabilities for Naval communications and satellite tracking. The program is scheduled for completion in late 1964.
