maintenance and inspection of jet fighter planes currently in use by the Air Force. He is a graduate of Narbonne High School.



During the training, Crume received instruction in the operation and capabilities of the movable bridge. Transported and launched by a converted tank, the bridge can be placed over a ravine, culvert or other difficult terrain. Its ability to move into forward positions over rugged terrain makes this modern Army tool a formidable piece of equipment.

Crume, a cook in the 12th Engineer Battalion in Germany, entered the Army in November 1962. He completed basic training at Ft. Leonard Wood, Mo., and arrived overseas in April 1963. The 23-year-old soldier attended North High School and was employed by the Border Market, Torrance, before entering the Army.

Annual Rodeo Headlines Ranchero Days Program

Annually celebrated with a carnival and rodeo, Torrance Ranchero Days will run from July 31 to August 4, police Lieutenant Don Cook announced.

As in the past, the Torrance Junior Chamber of Commerce will sponsor the carnival, which will be held in Del Amo Center near Madrona and Sepulveda.

Torrance Mounted Police will put on the Rodeo Saturday August 3 and Sunday, August 4, with the starting time set for 2 p.m. on both days. The Rodeo and the coronation of the Queen of Ranchero Days, will bring the five-day celebration to an end.

Selection of the queen will be based on ticket sales of the community service clubs that will participate. Last year, 15 service clubs took part in the event with game booths at the carnival.

As an additional attraction for the Rodeo, the Torrance Mounted Police will give an eight-day trip to Hawaii for

two people as a grand prize. The drawing will be held at 3:30 p.m. on August 4 at the Rodeo.


