**Parents Urged to Act Now on Polio Vaccine**

Parents and students were reminded this week that all enrollees in the public schools, including junior colleges, must be immunized against polio before admission. Students must have had the first dose of the vaccine, or must have been immunized for a previous school year. Students who haven't been immunized will be admitted, provided they obtain the first dose within two weeks. The only exceptions to the

state requirement are persons who have filed a statement that immunization is contrary to belief or doctor's advice. Persons included are all new kindergarten enrollees, all transfers at any level, and all pupils entering public schools in the county for the first time. Immunization is available from all doctors and at all health centers. School officials will not administer the vaccine.

**Science Fiction Writer To Address Manuscripters**

Fritz Leiber, a well known science fiction writer, will address the July meeting of the Southwest Manuscripters. The group will meet at Clark Stadium in Hermosa Beach Friday at 8 p.m.
