Peninsula Shopping Center Still Continues Fantastic Growth Rate

Progressing hand-in-hand with the booming Palos Verdes Peninsula is the Peninsula Center.

Located less than 10 minutes from any part of the Peninsula, the center was started less than 36 months ago but has already doubled in size. George Wright, manager of the Palos Verdes office of Capital Co., the primary developer of the center, says the value of units in the area is approaching \$7 million. The dynamic rate of growth in the Peninsula, at present over 1000 homes are in the construction state, has alerted sophisticated investors to the future of the center.

CURRENTLY, the Peninsula's rate of growth is over four times that of Los Angeles County. The Peninsula's three incorporated cities, Rolling Hills, Palos Verdes Estates, and Rolling Hills Estates, are Los Angeles County's first, third

and fourth ranking cities in median family income which contributes to the growth.

Investors are also lured by population projections which indicate that by 1980, there will be over 100,000 residents in the Palos Verdes Hills.

New developments in the Peninsula Center, when completed within the next year, will again double its size.
