

### Medical Specialists Asked To Check Air Force Program

College students who are working toward a degree in occupational or physical therapy may find welcome news in the "Medical Specialist Student Program" now offered by the Air Force.

The program, open to female students only, provides an opportunity for qualified applicants to draw full pay and allowances of an Air Force Second Lieutenant during the senior year of a four year course leading to a degree in Occupational or Physical Therapy, in approved schools. Upon completion of her studies the applicant is required to serve on active duty with the Air Force for two years.

According to S/Sgt. Ray Stauble, local Air Force recruiter, accepted applicants are commissioned as Air Force officers but will wear civilian clothes while attending school. The student therapist is required to pay tuition fees and other expenses but she will receive second lieutenant's pay

and allowance the same as if she were on active duty.

SERGEANT Stauble also emphasized that the same program is open to students possessing bachelor's degrees who meet the academic prerequisites and have been accepted for a 12-month certificate in an approved school of Occupational or Physical Therapy. Students who possess bachelor's degrees and have been accepted for training in an approved hospital Dietetic Internship are also eligible to apply. In these cases the students are paid while completing the certificate course or serving the Dietetic Internship.

74.73 per cent of the quota, and 72.21 per cent of their business quota.

Following Wilmington for overall quota in percentage of returns are:

Harbor City-Lomita, 46.46 per cent; San Pedro, 36.36 per cent; Gardena, 30.41 per cent; Torrance, 29.48 per cent; Rolling Hills, 24.28 per cent; and Palos Verdes, 6.02 per cent.

GARDENA, with 66.93 per cent of its quota, has the highest rate of income towards meeting the residential quota. Following Gardena are:

Harbor City-Lomita, 62.44 per cent; Wilmington, 39.43

per cent; San Pedro, 29.42 per cent; Rolling Hills, 24.28 per cent; and Palos Verdes, 6.90 per cent.

Behind Wilmington in advance gift returns are Torrance, 58.63 per cent; and San Pedro, 54.39 per cent.

Overall, the seven communities in the Harbor area have attained 31.88 per cent of their \$108,000 quota. Advance gifts, with 60.76 per cent has the highest per cent of income at present. Following are:

Business 42.31 per cent; public employees and schools, 34.3 per cent; commerce and industry, 28.4 per cent; and residential, 26.54 per cent.


This is a brand new idea in cookie making, using an unusual ingredient—pop corn—that's becoming quite the rage for new and different recipes.

PARTY SALAD

1 cup dairy sour cream  
1 cup whipping cream

Drain cherries. Save syrup. Heat 1 cup cherry syrup to boiling and pour over gelatin. Stir until gelatin is dissolved. Chill until consistency of unbeaten egg white. Stir in mayonnaise and sour cream. Beat with rotary beater until smooth. Stir in cherries.

Whip cream and fold into gelatin mixture. Spoon into 8 individual molds or a 1 1/2 quart salad mold. Chill until firm.
